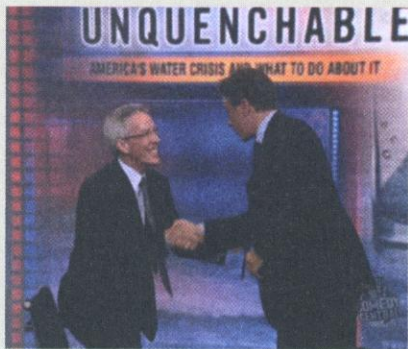


# Backstage with Jon Stewart

American Rivers STAC Member Appears on The Daily Show

Robert Glennon, a Professor of Law and Public Policy at the University of Arizona and a member of American Rivers Scientific and Technical Advisory Council (STAC), recently appeared on The Daily Show with Jon Stewart to discuss his most recent book *“Unquenchable: America’s Water Crisis and What To Do About It.”* The book captures the tragedy of America’s water crisis in a way that is both frightening and comical. manufactured snow for tourists in Atlanta to trillions of gallons of water flushed down the toilet each year, *Unquenchable* reveals the extravagances and everyday inefficiencies that are sucking the nation dry.

We asked Professor Glennon to share his behind-the-scenes experience:

## *Is Jon Stewart funny when he's not on camera?*

He was cracking one-liners one after another. He has a mind that doesn't stop.

## *Had he read your book?*

He's a voracious reader with a photographic memory. He had read my book and asked questions about things he wouldn't have known if he hadn't. While other talk shows have producers who book the guests, Jon Stewart is the one who decides who will appear on his show.

## *What was it like to be a guest?*

Jon Stewart came into the green room before the show and spent some time joking around and taking pictures with my family. The interview was conducted in front of a live studio audience of more than 200 people and it was entirely unscripted. While the producer and I had talked about topics ahead of time, the interview itself was completely ad-libbed.
